This newsletter may arrive just in time for Christmas but history has shown that *Maukonens* are not careless about time. In fact one, *Waino Maukonen*, was recognized as a person to help others keep track of their time. The clock shown at the left is engraved:

1912 W. Maukonen Helsinki

Jyrki and Hannele visited the clock museum in Helsinki where they saw this piece made by Väinö (Waino), a very famous Finnish clock maker. He moved to New York in 1916 and died there in 1929.

The chronometer shown above is 10cm by 10cm and may be the only piece in Finland that displays his name on the faceplate. His other timepieces are in the Residence of the President of Finland. You can find out more about Finnish clocks by visiting the website:

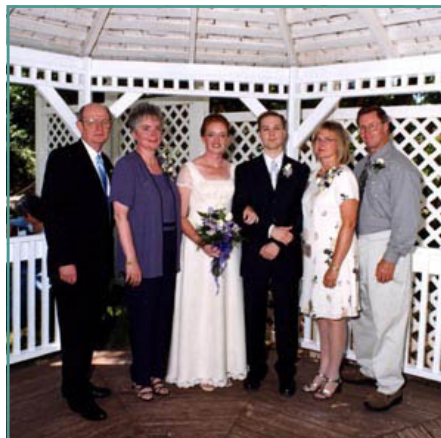

♦ Ida E. Fritsch (Phoenix, Arizona) wrote: *"My grandfather was Ville Wilhelm Maukonen (aka Maki in USA). His surname was changed to Maki by Immigration officials. He applied for naturalization in Idaho and [it] was granted in Montana. He married Iida Kimmunen (of Kontiolahti, Finland) on 20 Oct 1906 in Missoula, Missoula Co., Montana. She went back to Finland, and my mother was born in Sortavala on 28 Jul 1907. Then, when my mother was 5 years old, they came and met Grandpa in Florida, where he was farming and growing strawberries. I was never told any history, and wouldn't have known any of the genealogy, if my Grandmother hadn't written it down, and my Aunt gave it to me 18 years ago, just before my Grandmother died at 99 years and 10 months old. My Grandfather died on 28 Oct 1955 in Tampa, Florida at age 87 yrs. He was born 20 Nov 1867 in Rautalampi. My Great Grandfather was Torppari Israel Maukonen and Great Grandmother was Agneta Sofia Tittinen."*

♦ Ida's mother was Tyyne Katri Sofia Maki (or *Maukonen*). Ida's aunt is Illa Helen (née Maki or *Maukonen*) Van Vlack who lives in Summerfield, FL.

Canadian Cluster

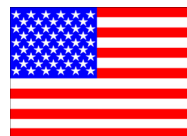
Cluster Ancestry
